



Quick Step Guide To Cleaning and Sanitizing Your Pool Furniture and Umbrellas



Aluminum Frame Vinyl Strap Or Sling Pool Furniture

1. Remove furniture from direct sunlight if not in use.
2. Place a towel on the patio furniture before sitting or lying on it to reduce your furniture's exposure to sunscreen and body oils.
3. Wash your outdoor aluminum furniture with soapy water every three weeks or more often if needed. Use a mild detergent and a soft rag or brush to clean the vinyl straps and aluminum frame. Get the pollutants, such as sunscreen or chlorine, off immediately.
4. For more advanced cleaning, prepare a solution with 10% bleach, 20% solvent-free neutral detergent and 70% water and apply the solution to vinyl straps or sling fabric.
5. Wax the aluminum frame with a light, non-compound car wax, such as Turtle Wax©. Buff out scratches on the frame with Soft Scrub© and a soft rag.



Umbrellas And Shade Structures

1. Brush off dust and dirt with a soft brush. NEVER brush with stiff brushes.
2. Prepare a solution with 10% bleach, 20% solvent-free neutral detergent and 70% water
3. Apply the solution to the fabric, allowing to remain between 15 and 20 minutes maximum.
4. Rinse with clean water several times. Any bleach residue remaining on the canvas, combined with the sun, could damage the fabric and stitching.
5. Let air dry and do not close the umbrella until the canvas is completely dry.
6. Repeat the process if necessary.
